the "ISAT U") and the ALPHA CENTAURI ELECTRICAL SERVICES, INC. with office address
at #34 Muelle Loney St., Iloilo City, Philippines represented by its President, ENGR. ERWIN U.
QUE (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR").

WHEREAS, ISAT U through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), posted the Request for Quotation (RFQ) No. SVP-2024-140 on the ISAT U and PhilGEPS websites and at a conspicuous place within the premises of the University, continuously, starting from July 17, 2024 to July 23, 2024, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Nine Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (Php 980,000.00) only as indicated in the Purchase Request No. SVP-2024-140;

WHEREAS, the Entity is desirous that the Contractor execute the SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, TESTING & COMMISSIONING OF POWER SUPPLY REQUIREMENTS FOR CEA LABORATORY EQUIPMENT (hereinafter called "the Works") located at ISAT U, Burgos St., La Paz, Iloilo City;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions set forth herein, that parties agree as follows;

The CONTRACTOR shall perform and complete all the works specified in the contract within SEVENTEEN (17) Calendar Days from the date of receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

ARTICLE III

(Contract Amount)

In consideration for the lump sum contract of EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY SEVEN PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (PHP 875,647.50) ONLY or such other sums as may be ascertained, CONTRACTOR agrees to enter into a contract with ISAT U for the SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, TESTING & COMMISSIONING OF POWER SUPPLY REQUIREMENTS FOR CEALABORATORY EQUIPMENT in accordance with its quotation.

The ISAT U agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the quotation.

ARTICLE IV

(Contractor's Warranty of Works)

The CONTRACTOR guarantees that all materials it will supply under this agreement are brand new, free from defects and strictly in accordance with the Technical Specifications on the quality of the materials and workmanship.

The CONTRACTOR shall assume full responsibility for the contract of work from the time the project construction commenced up to its final acceptance by the ISAT U and shall be responsible for any damage or destruction of works except those occasioned by force majeure as provided in Section 62.2.3.2 of the Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184 shall be observed.

The CONTRACTOR undertakes at its own expense to undertake all repairs and/or replacement of materials, facilities and equipment or parts thereof which are found by the ISAT U to be defective and which are brought to the attention of the CONTRACTOR within thirty (30) days from the discovery thereof.

Within a period of twelve (12) months after the completion and final acceptance of the Project, the CONTRACTOR shall remain liable for any damage/s discovered on the works due to faulty construction methods or the use of materials of inferior quality or violation of the terms and conditions of this contract. Any defect in the Project brought to the attention of the CONTRACTOR shall be corrected or replaced without any additional cost on the part of the ISAT U.

ARTICLE V

(Liquidated Damages)

In the event the CONTRACTOR refuses or fails to satisfactorily complete the work within the specified contract time, plus any time extension duly granted, and is in default under the contract, the CONTRACTOR agrees to pay ISAT U for liquidated damages (LD) in an amount equal to one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion for everyday of delay. ISAT U shall have the option to deduct the liquidated damages from payments or any money due or which may become due to the CONTRACTOR under this Contract and/or collect such liquidated damages from

the retention money or other securities posted by the CONTRACTOR whichever is convenient to ISAT U. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of this Contract, ISAT U may rescind this Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to ISAT U.

ARTICLE VI (Settlement of Disputes)

The settlement of disputes or differences of any kind whatsoever that arises between the parties in the connection with the implementation of the contract shall be settled in accordance to Rule XVIII (Settlements of Disputes) under the revised IRR of RA 9184.
